- Cleaning Deposit: A separate check for \$25 trash deposit must be received with the booth fee. This fee will be returned if the booth area is left clean after tear down.
- Application for booth assignment and crafts will be considered by the date booth fee is received. Please list all items to be sold in your booth; your crafts will be limited to your application. **ALL ARTS OR CRAFTS MUST BE HAND MADE.** Vendors are prohibited from distributing food or drink items that maybe consumed on premises, samples only.
- **ALL BOOTHS MUST BE OPEN BETWEEN 9AM AND 4PM.** Booth set up is between 6am and 9am on the day of the show. Vehicles must be moved from street by 8:30am. Late arriving vendors may forfeit booth fee or booth assignment. No vendor may leave prior to the 4pm tear down.
- Tucker Celebration is held rain or shine and booth fee is non-refundable.
- **IMPORTANT:** If you are new to this event you must submit a picture of your booth with application.
